- Once annually, CSI members may submit their professional work/service to be highlighted on the Center for Scholastic Inquiry's website and in our newsletter. Sharing our best work and professional achievements advances the field of research and elevates the professions of education, business, and behavioral sciences. Additionally, you gain visibility for your professional interests and pursuits.
- As a CSI member, special discounts are extended to you for additional CSI offerings. You save 5% on future conference registrations by simply entering your membership code when making your selections and the discount will be applied.
- All members of the Center for Scholastic Inquiry are eligible to apply for research scholarships.
 Each quarter, CSI will award two \$250 scholarships. Members may use the funds for research initiatives. To support and advance as much academic and action research as possible, members are limited to one research scholarship per year. Members can apply for scholarships on the CSI website membership page.
- At our face-to-face conferences, members of the Center for Scholastic Inquiry also are invited
 to join us for our executive board suppers scheduled during each research conference. In
 addition to enjoying the collegiality and contribution, you will also receive a voucher to defray
 the cost of your meal.
- Membership with the Center for Scholastic Inquiry also affords you a chance to win an event scholarship. Prior to each academic research conference, CSI will randomly select one member to receive an event scholarship which waives the registration fee for an upcoming conference within one calendar year.
