



Conflict of Interest Policy

To have your manuscript reviewed by CSI (Center for Scholastic Inquiry) has not been submitted to, nor is under review at, another journal or other publishing venue. Further, the authors cannot have affiliations with organizations with direct or indirect financial interest in the subject matter discussed in the manuscript.

Additional conflict of interest can occur when you have a professional relationship with our organizations that could influence your research being published. If you are serving CSI in any capacity, you must notify the editor of your affiliation upon submission.

If any board member submits for publication, the editor will firstly use this information to inform his or her editorial decisions. They may then publish such disclosures to assist readers in evaluating the article, may utilize external reviewers through the double blind review process, or the editor may decide not to publish your article on the basis of any declared conflict.
