Task 1: Note &	Review Your Presentation Date and Time
	You will receive an email with your presentation date and time, please be sure to review it and plan accordingly.
Task 2: Review	Conference Program Information
	Please review your conference title, summary, and presenter information (below) for accuracy. If something is highlighted in red, we <u>need</u> you to complete and/or verify the information for us. If what we have is correct, there is no need to respond.
	If there is a strike through a presenters name, it means they are either not registered, or have not finalized their registration with payment. CSI's policy on ethics prohibits including anyone in the program who is not actually presenting. With that said, we will include non-attending authors within our online proceedings.
	If there is a strike through the name of one of authors, please be sure to have him/her register and make payment, make payment for a pending registration, or notify us to remove them. If one of these actions is not taken by <u>Wednesday</u> , <u>March 19th @ 8:00 AM CST</u> , that specific presenter will be removed from the program. If it is a one-presenter presentation, the entire presentation will be removed.
	If corrections are necessary, please submit them to <u>csiteam@csiresearch.com</u> no later than <u>Wednesday</u> , <u>March 19th @ 8:00 AM CST</u> . If we do not hear from you, we will assume that everything is correct, and print the program.
